Early childhood education in Italy

*"It is universally recognised that **early childhood care and education** is more than preparation for primary school. It aims at the holistic development of a child's social, emotional, cognitive and physical needs and it is one of the **best investments** a country can make to promote human resource development, gender equality and social cohesion, and to reduce the costs for later remedial programmes". (UNESCO)*



Italian culture has had a leading role in recognising and promoting early childhood education: Italian pedagogies such as **Montessori** and **Reggio** are well known and adopted all over the world.

Despite this, the circumstances of our actual society present many challenges and also Italian educational institutions make constantly a lot of efforts in finding **innovation, new skills** and **abilities** to adapt to the lack of public funding, the demographic decline, the increasing number of children with non-Italian background or with physical or learning difficulties and the lack of parental competence in education.

The program of the study visit is organized **according to the needs** of the participants (kindergarten teachers, school managers, trainers) and gives a comprehensive overview of the Italian situation. The study visit can also be an excellent **opportunity to establish contacts** with teachers and school managers to start a transnational cooperation.

The possible topics covered during the study visit are:

- The structure of childhood education
- Organization, funding and legislation
- Inclusion of children with disabilities or special needs
- Intercultural education
- The Reggio Emilia Approach
- The implementation of the Montessori
- The implementation of the Steiner (Waldorf) method
- Involvement and cooperation with parents
- Pet therapy in day care centres and kindergartens
- Psychomotricity in day care centres and kindergartens
- Nutritional education
- Furniture and equipment in day care centres and kindergartens
- Staff initial and continuous training

The study tour includes visits to **municipal and private crèches**, kindergartens and centres providing **educational and therapeutic activities** for children. Meetings with childhood **policy makers**, managers of public and private institutions and **experts** on growth and children's difficulties complete the programme.
